

# A major contested election, a white hot sports team and an active, eventful month. With all that was going on, why did we have fewer productions than last year?



The fact of the matter is that we are living through times as a town where there is a lot going on. The challenge of the town meeting decision on the MBTA Communities Zoning Law is gaining momentum, all of our high school varsity teams have been performing really well, with a special shout-out to our Rockets Football team, who have been undefeated this season. 
